BRIEF HISTORY

New as fleet number O.87, it was renumbered O.34 in 1953.

Purchased as one of a batch of six identical vehicles, it was retained as a spare after the others were replaced in the early 1960's. It was sold in 1969 to the West Riding Transport Society and arrived at Sandtoft in October 1971. It was instrumental in the initial construction of the Museum's overhead circuit.

Outside storage has caused serious deterioration. Awaiting restoration, it can be viewed with the assistance of a member of staff.
