


# Isle of Axholme Running Day Services

Sunday 20th October will see a number of free vintage bus services in operation, alongside a large event taking place at the Trolleybus Museum in Sandtoft. Using a mix of both resident and visiting vehicles, these services are open to all members of the public and will operate like any other, stopping on request at the marked bus stops along the routes below.

If you wish to board, please make a clear signal to the driver by putting your hand out as the bus approaches. It is essential that you give the signal in good time as some of our drivers may not be overly familiar with the area.

Please be mindful that most of these services will be operated by vintage buses, some of which are over 70 years old! This will mean, that due to the vehicles designs, we are regrettably unable to accommodate wheelchairs or unfolded pushchairs, and some of the buses may have several steep or high steps to negotiate.

Whilst every effort will be made to operate the services as advertised, sometimes circumstances beyond our control may cause us to deviate from these original plans.



All services operate free of charge.  
 Museum admission is not required nor is it granted whilst using these services.  
 Access to free services may be prohibitive to some due to the age and design of the vehicles in use.

All routes operate a one way loop in Epworth (see above)
